

Dear Hunter

We host a company drawing each year based on a points system to try and make it as fair as possible for all. Our success rate over the last several years makes many hunters interested in using our services. The past 5 years have produced a 94% success rate. Take this with a grain of salt as any outfitter will tell you numbers that you want to hear. We can back this up with facts and data. Unit 18 is the highest populated moose unit in Alaska. So much so, that the state allowed residents of the unit to harvest up to 3 moose per person last year. This has never happened in any other unit in the state, ever. Unit 18 is a no antler restriction unit. You can shoot any bull moose you see or think is unique. It removes the challenges of determining width or number of brow tines. We do over 40 hours of moose scouting and only drop hunters if there are big trophy moose in the immediate area. A typical trophy moose is 55-63 inches wide. 2022 was the best year for large trophy moose as the average width was 59 inches. Previous years averages have been around 55 inches.

We like to think of our operation as being very “turn- key” once you have boots on the ground in Bethel. Here is what is included in the hunt.

- One on one phone time for all questions
- Seasoned, knowledgeable, and well-trained employees
- Gear checked and someone available to review before your hunt
- 2 hours of individual group meetings in person at our facility prior to your hunt for all rules and regulations for hunters
- We are an e-vendor, so you have the ability to purchase your licenses and locking tags on site
- If you tag out early, we will be able to change your commercial airline flights for you
- All expediting and logistical support in Bethel, including to/from the airport, the butcher, and cargo carriers
- 40+ hours of aerial scouting prior to hunting season in GMU 18
- Weather permitting, meat extraction as soon as we are able (drop camp locations only) (Float hunts are limited to those hunters who have bagged a Yukon moose before)
- Early extraction from the field if your group tags out before your pull-out date.
- Staging areas for gear organization
- Storage facility for any bags/gun cases that you leave behind
- Lodging facility on site
- Covered area for cleaning antlers as well as providing all packing material for antlers
- Assistance with Alaska Airlines in Bethel for check in and baggage
- We provide the option to purchase game bags, totes, wax boxes, coolers, etc
- Knowledgeable employee that will review your hunting location(s) prior to drop off



- If you choose to donate any meat, we arrange that for you, and handle the donation to the community
- Assistants with shipping meat back home using our known shipper number or Alaska Trophy Express
- On site walk-in freezer storage for meat

We are currently booked for 2023, and 2024. The 2025 drawing is now closed. Should you want to apply for 2026, applications start on November 15th, 2023.

The 2025 price has been set at \$12,500 per hunter. This includes the use of our rental gear water craft, as many flights as it takes to get you into and out of the bush for persons, gear, and meat. There is no discount for bringing your own gear. You are limited to 100 pounds per person of personal gear.
